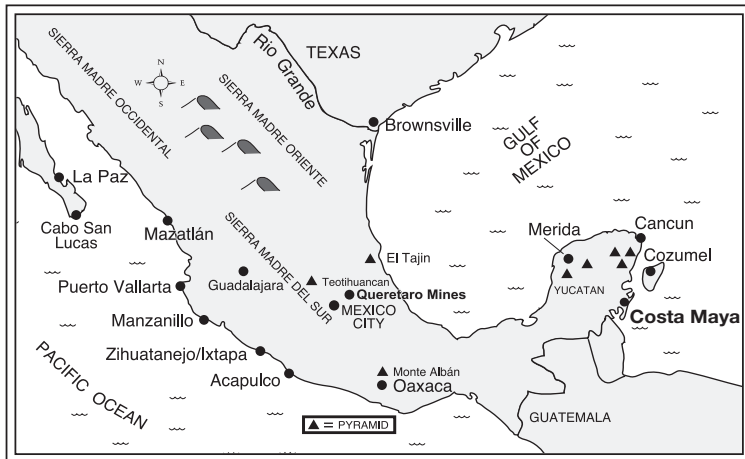


# Spotlight on Costa Maya



## HISTORY

People began living in the Costa Maya area of the Quintana Roo region around 2000 B.C. The area was active primarily in marine trade. In 1528, Spanish conquistadors attacked the coast; in 1544 the port city Bacalar fell. The new Spanish settlers lacked the skills to cultivate the land, and the Mayan Indians refused to work for their conquerors. The Spanish finally retreated inland when pirates attacked the settlement.

Mexico gained independence in the early 1800's, but Quintana Roo felt no change. In the mid 1800's, natives rebelled against the ruling occupants. The Mayans nearly ousted the Yucatecan Army from the region, but the rainy season came and the Mayans stopped fighting to tend to their crops. The Yucatecan Army reclaimed the cities they had lost.

In the late 1800's and early 1900's, rebellious Mayans traded local hardwoods for weapons and continued fighting, isolating Quintana Roo. Finally in the early 20th century, the government established a customs station, putting an end to weapons trading and making Quintana Roo a safe place for trade and settlement.

In 1904, Quintana Roo became a state. It remained quiet and unsettled until 1920, when President Diaz declared it a penal colony. From 1920 to 1929, the sap of the Chicozapote tree, chicle, was the main crop in Quintana Roo. The sap was used to make chewing gum until substitutes were developed. In the 1950's, the economy boomed with exports of mahogany and cedar.

In 1974, the first hotels in Cancun opened. By 1999, 36% of Mexico's tourism revenue was accounted for by Quintana Roo. Today, Costa Maya is quickly developing into a haven for the world's travelers because of its inexpensive real estate, beautiful beaches and welcoming people.

## LOCAL WARES

Once home to the ancient Mayans, Costa Maya and the rest of the Yucatan area are the best places to find Mayan artifacts and replicas of Mayan art, crafts and jewelry. Fine silver jewelry and beautiful pottery and leather goods abound. While in Costa Maya, try some chewing gum made from real, locally grown chicle plants, the original source of chewing gum.

## DOCKING/TENDERING

The ship will dock at Puerto Costa Maya.

Costa Maya offers jewelry stores, beachwear and Mexican specialties such as silver and handicrafts. In addition, the port area offers a plaza at the pier with shopping and a saltwater swimming pool.

## CAPITAL

The capital of the Mexican state of Quintana Roo is Chetumal.

## LOCATION

Costa Maya is located in the Yucatan Peninsula, 150 miles south of Cancun. It sits between Placer and Xcalak in the state of Quintana Roo.

## SIZE

Quintana Roo covers an area of 19,630 square miles (50,842 square kilometers).

## POPULATION

Majahual and Xcalak each have a population of less than 400. The population of the entire state is 493,277.

## LANGUAGE

The official language of Mexico is Spanish. Most shop clerks and other service personnel speak English.

## CURRENCY

The official currency is the peso. United States dollars, travelers checks and credit cards are widely accepted.

## TIME ZONE

Costa Maya is on Central Standard Time, one hour earlier than Eastern Standard Time. The ship may not always follow local time. Please adhere to the ship's time while in port.

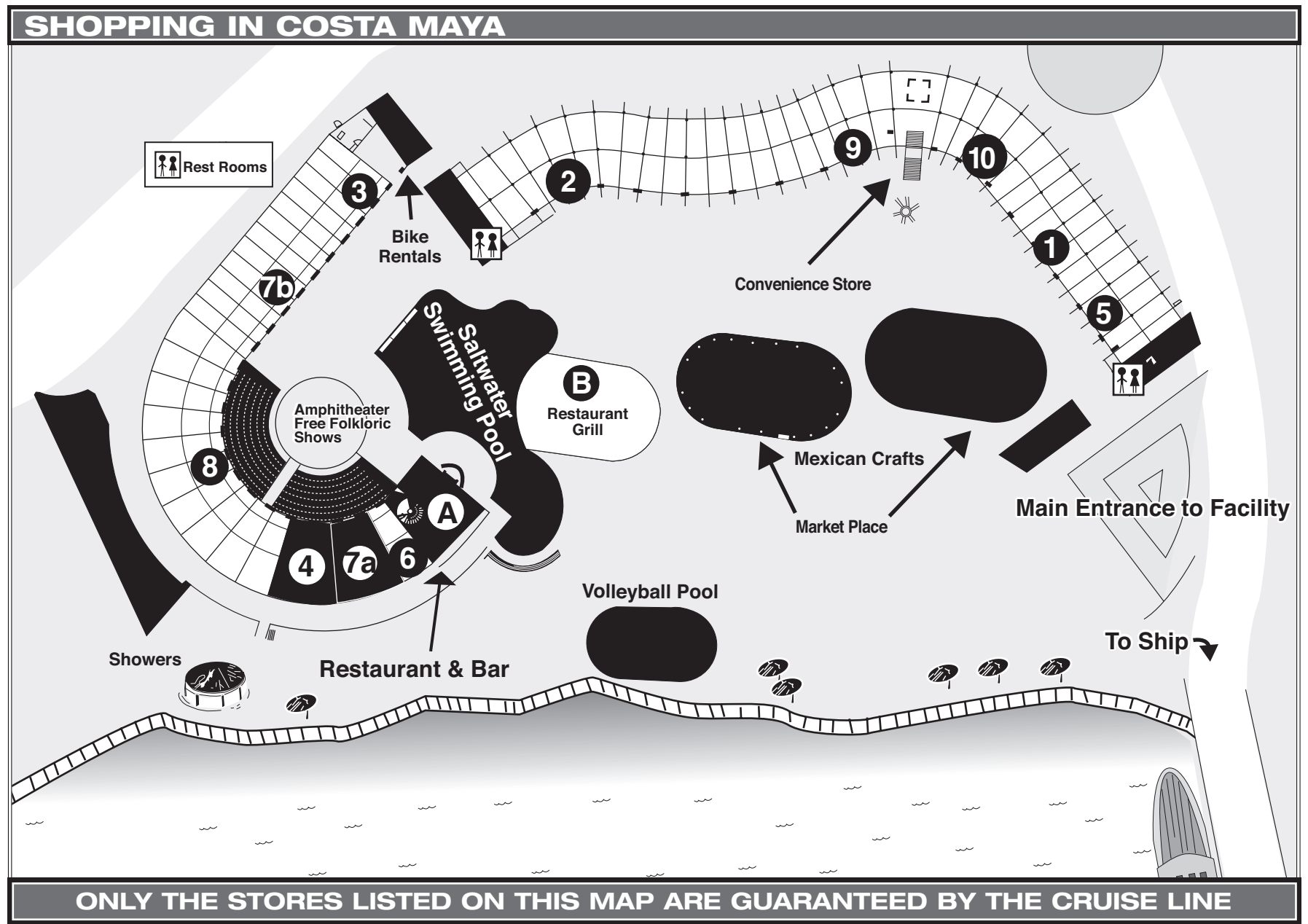
