Labadee, Haiti

Labadee is a 260-acre wooded peninsula at Pointe Ste. Honore about six miles from Cap Haitien on the mountainous and secluded northern coast of Haiti. Discovered in 1492 by Christopher Columbus, Labadee was later used as a trading post by visiting ships and their crews. The peninsula has been restored since the time of the buccaneers and now features abundant activities for guest of all ages.
