As we return to sea, your health and safety remains our top priority. We've partnered with expert medical and scientific minds to guide us in the development of comprehensive protocols to protect you and the ones you love. And we're working with local health authorities in our homeport countries to ensure our guests meet current inbound travel requirements. We're continually evaluating these protocols and will make updates as public health standards evolve. Guests already booked with us, will be notified with the latest requirements 30 days prior to departure.

According to the health protection protocols from the Hong Kong SAR Government, guests must meet below requirements in order to travel on Hong Kong 'Cruiseation':

1. Local residents bearing Hong Kong Identity Card.
2. Guests (except those unfit due to medical grounds) are required to complete full COVID-19 vaccination 14 days prior to boarding.
3. Complete and receive negative PCR test report within 48 hours prior to boarding.
4. Not been to or visit any specified extremely high-risk places identified by the SAR Government in the past 14 days.



### Testing For All

All guests aged 16 or above\* must complete full COVID-19 vaccination 14 days prior to boarding. This is not applicable to those unfit to receive vaccination because of health reasons (with medical certificate).

All guests aged between 12-15\* are required to follow HKSAR Gov regulations as below:

- Guests sailing between 1 Sept – 15 Oct, 2021 to complete first dose of COVID-19 vaccination

- Guests sailing after 15 Oct, 2021 are required to be fully vaccinated

All guests will also be required to test negative for SARS-CoV-2 (coronavirus) within 48 hours prior to boarding and to use “Leave Home Safe” APP at the cruise terminal.

\*All requirements are subject to change based on latest disease prevention measures by the HKSAR Gov.



## 100% Fresh, Filtered Air

There's nothing like the fresh air of the open ocean, wherever you are on board. On Royal Caribbean® ships, our HVAC system continuously supplies 100% fresh, filtered air from outdoors to all indoor spaces. You can breathe easy knowing that, thanks to this robust system, the transmission of aerosol particles between spaces (like those from a cough) is extremely low to virtually impossible — as validated in an independent assessment conducted by the University of Nebraska Medical Center and the National Strategic Research Institute on board a Royal Caribbean ship.

Royal Caribbean takes great pride in keeping our ships sparkling clean. Our evolved sanitization protocols use EPA-certified disinfectants and techniques like electrostatic fogging to clean frequently and consistently. Plus we've reduced the need to touch surfaces wherever possible.



## Upgraded Medical Facilities & Expert Care

That's why we've made our high-quality onboard medical care stronger than ever, with more doctors and nurses on each ship and state-of-the-art equipment enhancements. And in the event of a suspected case of COVID-19, we're fully prepared with sound care plans, including rapid testing onboard.



## Less Guests, More Social Distance

Everyone now knows the importance of physical distancing. We also know that on vacation you just want to relax. Royal Caribbean ships will sail with fewer guests onboard – no more than 50% of usual capacity – giving you more distance from others. Around the ship you'll find friendly reminders wherever face masks or extra spacing are required. ### **COVID-19 Assistance\***

- 100% cruise fare refund for you, and your travel party, if any of you tests positive for COVID-19 within 14 prior to the cruise or at the boarding terminal.
- 100% cruise fare refund for you, and your travel party, if any of you tests positive for COVID-19 during the cruise.
- If you test positive for COVID-19 during the cruise, Royal Caribbean will cover the costs of COVID-19 related medical treatment onboard, any required land-based quarantine, and travel home for you and your travel party.
