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Royal Caribbean TERMS AND CONDITIONS

By entering the *Royal Caribbean's Instagram Holiday Mode: Activated Giveaway Competition Terms And Conditions*

with Royal Caribbean competition (the "**Competition**"), you are agreeing to the following Terms and Conditions:

GENERAL

1. The Promoter ('the Promoter') of this Competition is RCL Cruises (ABN 54 150 263 086) of Level 15, 101 Miller Street North Sydney, NSW 2060.
2. Information on how to enter and prizes forms part of the Terms and Conditions. Entry into the Competition is deemed acceptance of these Terms and Conditions.
3. To the extent of any inconsistency between these Terms and Conditions and any other reference to this Competition, these Terms and Conditions will prevail.

WHO CAN ENTER?

4. The Competition is open to all Australian residents who are aged 18 years or older. The competition excludes employees (and their immediate families) of the Promoter and all companies and agencies associated with this Competition ("Entrants"). Immediate family means any of the following: spouse, ex-spouse, defacto spouse, child or step child (whether natural or by adoption), parent, step parent, grandparent, step grandparent, uncle, aunt, niece, nephew, brother, sister, step brother, step sister or first cousin.
5. Entrants into this Competition must be 18 years of age as at the date of entry in order to be eligible to enter the Competition.
6. The Promoter reserves the right to request winners to provide proof of identity, proof of residency in order to claim a prize. Requiring proof of identification and residency considered suitable for verification is at the discretion of the Promoter. The Promoter accepts no responsibility for any late, lost or misdirected entries including online messages not received by the Promoter or delays in the delivery of the message due to technical disruptions, network congestions or for any other reason.
