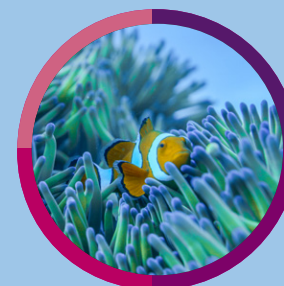
PORT DOUGLAS

Our HVAC system continuously intakes 100% fresh ocean air, filtering it for supply to all indoor rooms and areas.

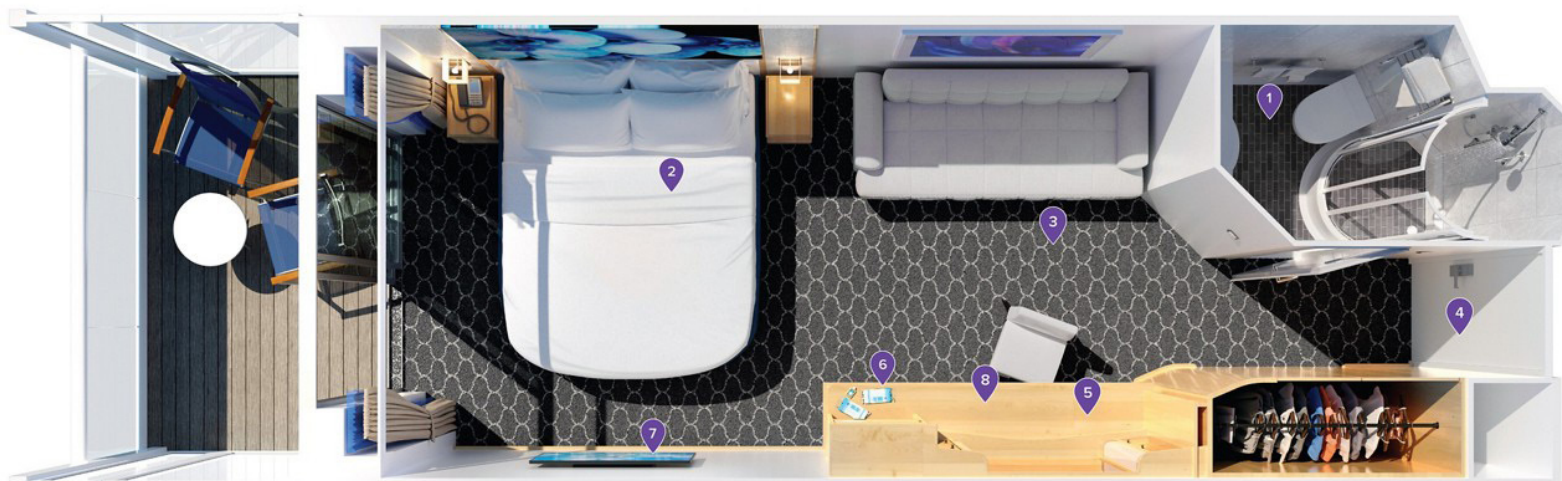

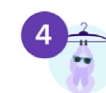
EPA-Certified Cleaning Agents

Your room is only serviced and sanitized by a stateroom attendant while you are out — and there are still towel animal surprises.



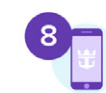

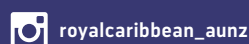
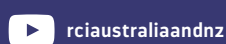
